

Dear Parents, Students, Teachers, and Building Occupants,

In 1986, Congress passed the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requiring schools to inspect and identify any asbestos-containing building materials (ACBM). The Otis School District hired a certified building inspector to identify and sample any suspect asbestos-containing building materials.

The law further requires the school to have an asbestos management plan. The Otis School District has an asbestos management plan available for review in the school district administrative office or the administrative office of the school during regular business hours. Updates for the year:

The only remaining ACBM is located in the announcers stand located east of the football field. The school maintenance staff inspected the condition of the materials every six months and the condition of the material remains in good condition. At a future date, we will hire a certified building inspector to re-inspect the ACBM for our required three year re-inspection.
